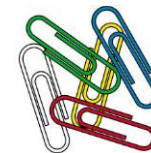


Year 1 Spring Curriculum Overview

- To understand celebrations within the Catholic church

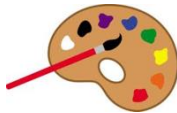
Science
