


Year 3 Summer Curriculum Overview

English

The areas covered this term will include, poetry, imaginative writing and instructions linked to our topic and science work, therefore will be many cross-curricular links. Within these we will be -

- Writing narratives through imagery and using our imaginations.
- Writing about real events.
- Using a range of verbs
- Evaluating our own work.

We will also be looking at possessive apostrophes, adding prefixes to words and inverted commas.

Mathematics

This term, our key objectives in Maths will be:

- * Secure all formal methods for addition, subtraction and multiplication.
- * Use mathematical knowledge to improve our mental maths.
- * Be able to find fractions of amounts.
- * Add fractions with the same denominator and begin to find unit and non-unit fractions of quantities.
- * Read and create a range of groups.



Religion

Our initial topic is Easter. Here we will be looking at the importance of Easter through some of the bible stories linked. We will then look at the importance of Prayer and Pentecost. Children will also be preparing for their First Holy Communion.

Science

The term we will be learning about plants. They will be learning about the different parts and all their functions as well as knowing which parts help with pollination. After half term the children will be learning about forces and magnets. They will investigate the different poles of magnets and which materials/objects are magnetic.

Topic

This term our topic is the football world cup. We will be learning using a lot of our geography skills and understanding some key features of the world particularly in the host country. We will also be looking at the different climates around the country and why they are like this. We will also be looking at the history of the world cup and how it has changed too.

Within this we will also be using our artist skills in creating pieces of artwork related to the different countries represented in the world cup.

Art and Design Technology (DT) and Music.


